

Sandwiches (Fred Penner)

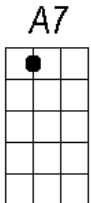
{Chorus}

But (F) if you have yourself a sandwich, won't you (A7) give a bite to (Dm) me?

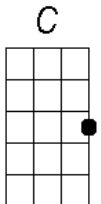
{Chorus}

She (F) handed me a sandwich and she (A7) threw me out the (Dm) door.



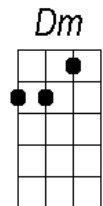
{Chorus}

But (F) I offered her a sandwich and she (A7) said she'd marry (Dm) me.



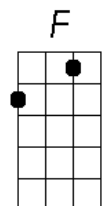
{Chorus}
