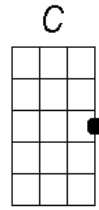


Take Me Home, Country Roads – Manitoba Version

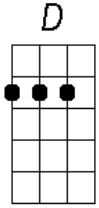

(D) Younger than the glaciers, (C) blowin' like a (G) breeze.

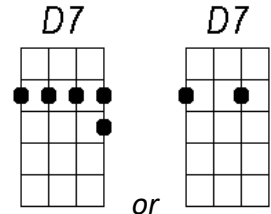


{Chorus}

Take me (C) home, country (G) roads

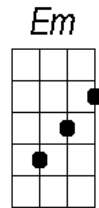


(G) The mosquitos, (Em) swarm around me,

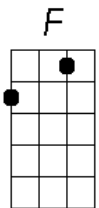
(G) Blowing north winds, (Em) frozen rivers,
