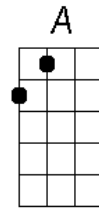


# Winter Wonderland

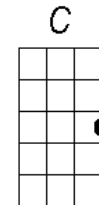
**{Intro}** A (G) beautiful (F) sight, we're (Em) happy (Dm) tonight,

In the (G7) lane, snow is glistening.

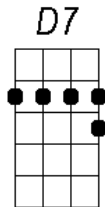
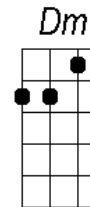
A (G) beautiful (F) sight, we're (Em) happy (Dm) tonight,

Gone (C) away, is the blue bird,

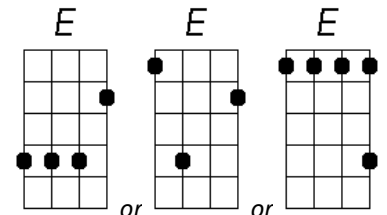
Here to (G7) stay, is the new bird,

Then pretend that (A) he is Parson (E) Brown.

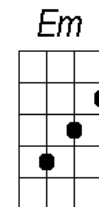
(G) He'll say "Are you (C) married?" We'll say (G) "No man,  
But you can (G) do the (D7) job when you're in (C) town."



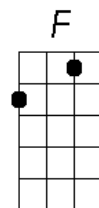
Later (C) on we'll conspire, as we (G7) dream, by the fire,
